Fusion – 97.24% 1 - late

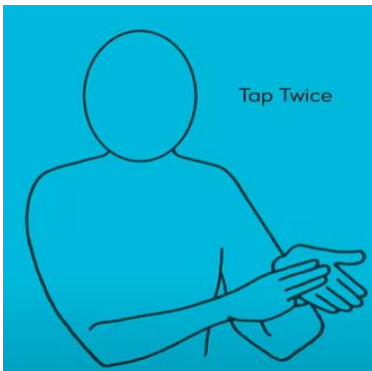
Dart – 90.95% 4 - late
