Relationship and Health Education Parent Consultation

The Department for Education has announced changes to relationships and sex education following nationwide consultation. These changes were due to come into effect from September 2020 but due to COVID-19 schools have been able to delay this until the summer term 2021.

The new guidance focuses on healthy relationships and keeping children safe in the modern world. It also covers a wide range of topics relating to physical and mental health, wellbeing, safeguarding and healthy relationships.

We have held off completing our consultation in the hope that we could do it face to face but the current Covid-19 situation has made it a little more challenging to consult with you. We have sent an email today to all families with the consultation details. This consultation will be via a Google Form and begins on 26th March and will close on 20th April.

Your views are very important to us and once we have considered all the feedback, the finalised Relationship Health Education Policy will be uploaded to the school's website where we will also set out the proposed curriculum. If you have any queries or concerns regarding the consultation process, please do not hesitate to contact the school.

Covid-19



Although safety measures are changing in line with the government roadmap, the government guidance for schools remains the same and our safety measures remain the same.

To keep us all safe please continue to follow our safety plans:

- If your child or anyone in your household is displaying symptoms or awaiting the outcome of a test, do not come to school - you must self-isolate the whole household during this time
- Maintain a 2 metre distance from other families and staff whilst at school
- Wear a face covering when you are on the school grounds
- Do not come into the school building
- Arrive at the correct staggered time for drop off and pick-ups (only one parent to drop off)
- Swiftly exit the school grounds
- Do not gather in groups
- Keep the one way system clear so everyone is able to safely enter and exit the school grounds
- Follow the government's current guidance outside of school at all times

Lateral Flow Tests

Lateral flow tests are available for households and bubbles of school children and staff - Households with primary school age children, including childcare and support bubbles, can test themselves twice every week at home. 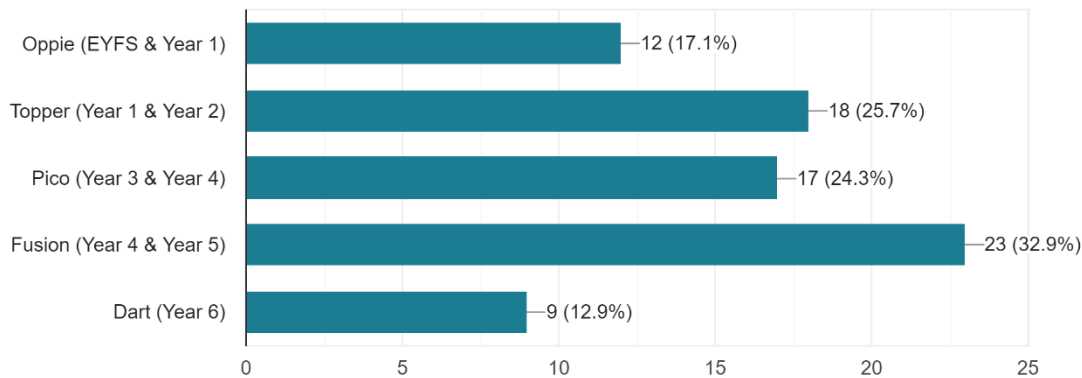

Remote Learning Parent Questionnaire March 2021



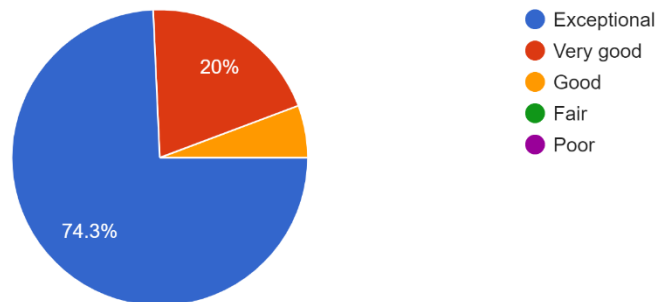
Which class is your child in?

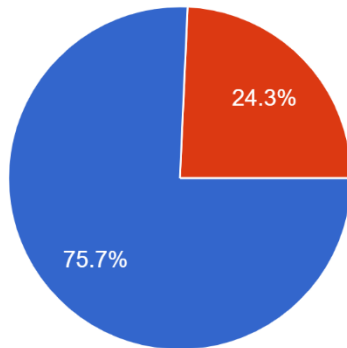
1. How would you rate the quality of remote learning that your child has received from the school during the lockdown?

3. The remote learning provision ensured that my child continued to make progress with their learning.

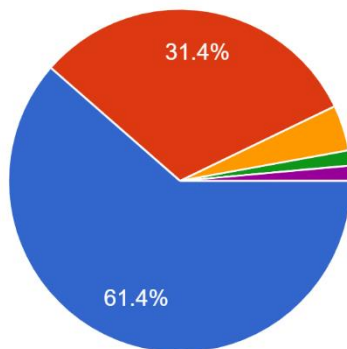

5. The daily live lessons on zoom were engaging for my child.

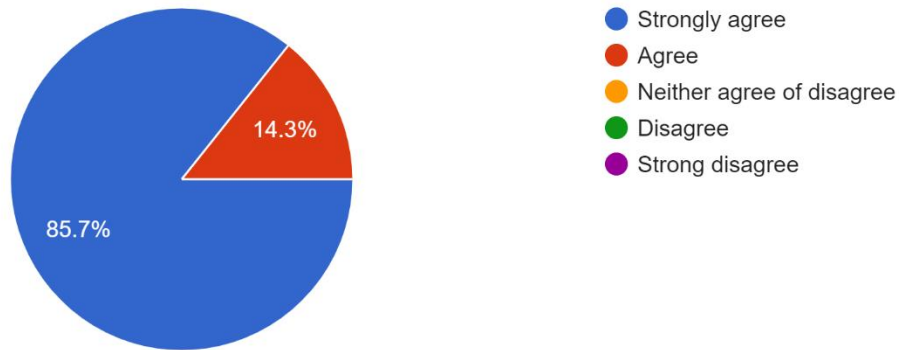

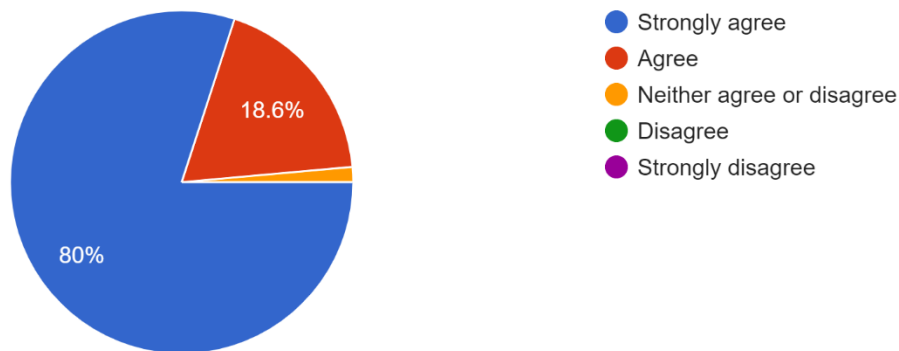
6. The school staff were available when my child needed help with their learning?

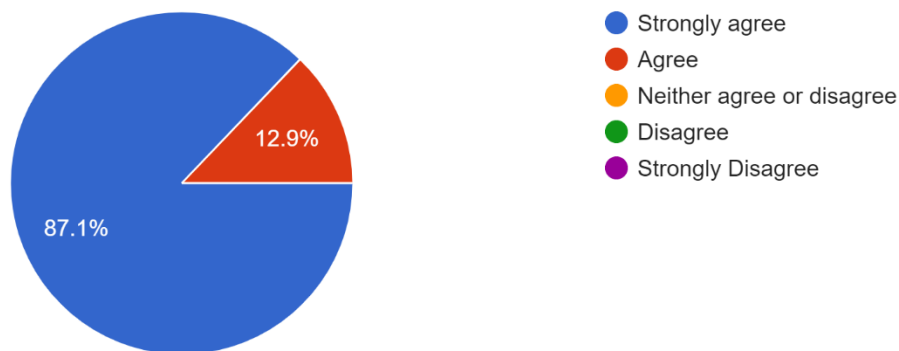
7. My child received prompt feedback. Either when observations were added to tapestry or when work was uploaded to Google Classrooms.

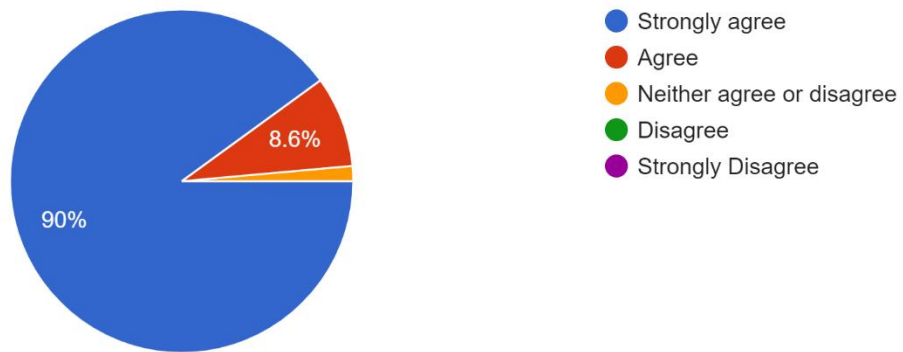
8. The school made the learning accessible by providing suitable learning resources (e.g. technology, books etc)

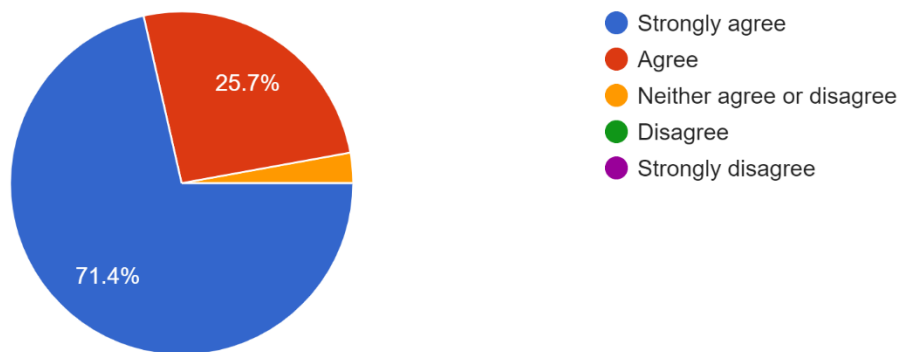
9. Communication from the school has been regular, clear and effective?
