They also took part in the Penryn Partnership rugby tournament this afternoon and came Second. They were incredible!

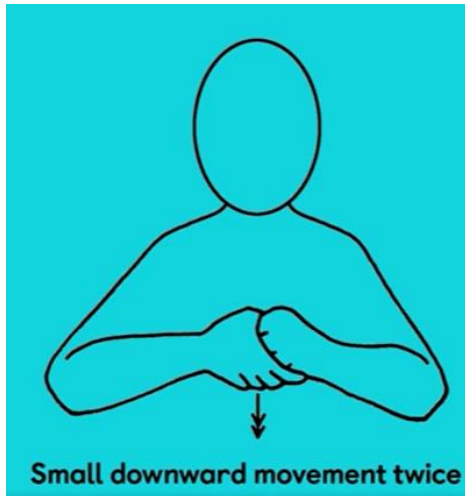
Celebration Assemblies
